NEWS RELEASE – 2011 Elections

January 31, 2011

At the Jan 5th 2011 regular meeting the JCCD board adopted a resolution to hold the 2011 Election for a supervisor on Mar. 2nd 2011, from 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. at the district office, in the Shold Business Park, located at 205 W. Patison St. Port Hadlock, Wa, 98339.

The board of supervisors is comprised of five members, each serving a three year term. Three of the 5 supervisors are locally elected by registered Jefferson County voters living within the district boundary (all of E. Jefferson County, excluding Port Townsend city limits). The other two are appointed by the Washington State Conservation Commission. Julie Boggs, John Boulton and Lige Christian are the three elected supervisors. Roger Short and Glen Huntingford are the 2 appointed supervisors. The position held by Julie Boggs is up for election this year. The position held by Glen Huntingford is up for appointment.

Candidates must declare their interest and eligibility by completing an eligibility form and providing it to the district office by February 2nd 2011. In order for a candidates' name to be placed on the official ballot, they must also complete a nomination petition and provide it to the district office by February 2nd, 2011. Elected Supervisor nominating petitions and appointed Supervisor applications may be obtained from either the district office or from the Wa. St. Conservation Commission in Olympia at 360-407-6200.
